Alcaligenes faecalis is an aerobic nonfermentative, oxidase-positive, nonencapsulated, gram-negative rod (1) It is so named for its ability to produce an alkaline reaction in certain media (2) *A. faecalis* is the most frequently isolated member of family Alcaligenaceae in the clinical laboratory It is present in soil and water as well

NOSOCOMIAL GRAM-NEGATIVE INFECTIONS

Gram-negative bacteria are typically non-pathogenic in the immunocompetent host This is especially true of the Enterobacteriaceae and the nonfermentative gram-negative bacilli However, in the debilitated host, gram-negative bacteria can become significant pathogens Our ability to prevent and treat gram-negative nosocomial infection is
